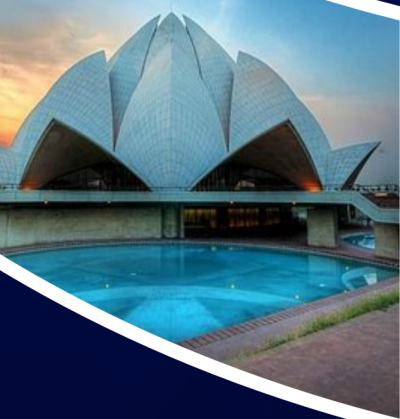

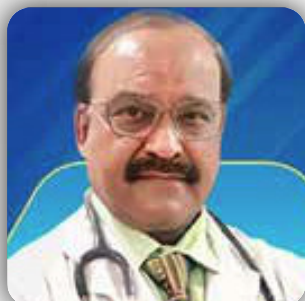

- Abstracts must be original and should not have been submitted / presented / intended for presentation elsewhere before DCCS-2024.
- All the papers must be submitted in English Language.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that the co-authors are aware & approve of the content. He / She should take responsibility for the accuracy of the results.
- The presenting author's name should be highlighted and the presenting author's full name, institution, phone number and email address must be provided.
- Please ensure the email address of the presenting author is accurate as acceptance of abstract and further communication will be only on this address.
- An e-mail confirming the receipt of abstract, including an abstract number, will be sent to the submitting delegate. This number should be quoted for all further correspondence.
- Notification regarding submission will be conveyed immediately to the corresponding author.
- Acceptance / Rejection will be notified only after review, approx. ONE month before the dates of the conference.
- Papers will be categorized as Oral and Poster.
- There will be NO extension of the date for abstract submission.
- A soft copy of the abstract must be submitted to isccmdelhichapter@gmail.com on the same day you submit the abstract online.
- Scientific Committee reserves the right to accept / reject / change the category (oral/poster) of your paper.

DELHI ATTRACTIONS



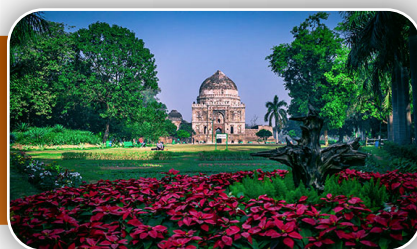
